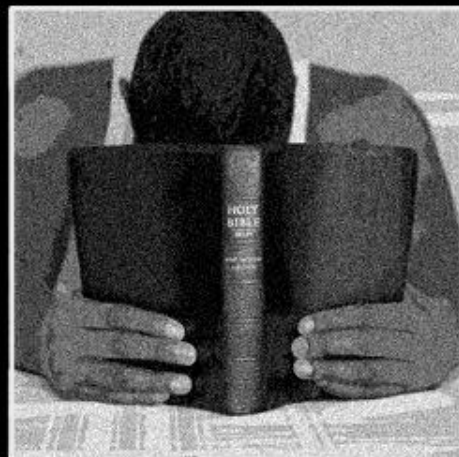



Significance of Baptism

1. Baptism is an act of Consecration



*...baptism...is the pledge
of a clear conscience toward God.*

Significance of Baptism

2. Baptism is an act of Renunciation

*... We died to sin; how can we live
in it any longer? Or don't you know
that all of us who were baptized
into Christ Jesus were baptized
into his death.*

Romans 6:2-3

Significance of Baptism

3. Baptism is an act of Expectation

*We were therefore buried with him
through baptism into death in order
that, just as Christ was raised
from the dead through the glory
of the Father, we too may live a new life.*

Romans 6:4

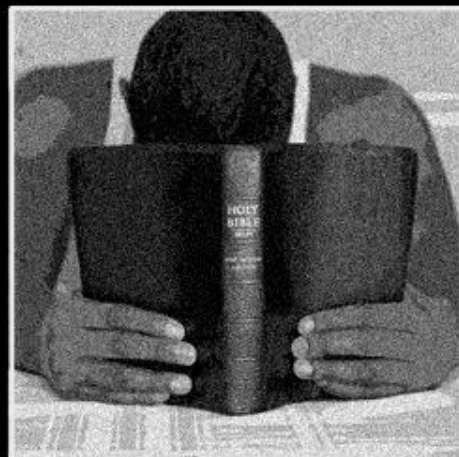
Significance of Baptism
