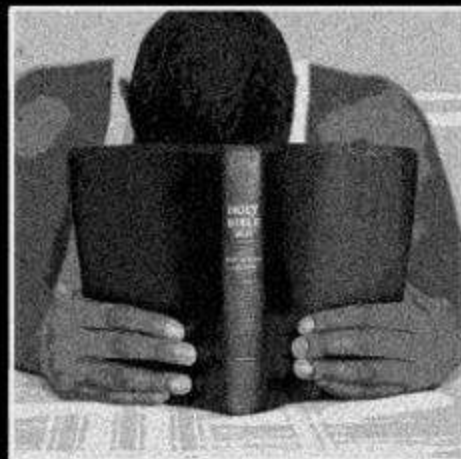

just as in Christ God forgave you.*



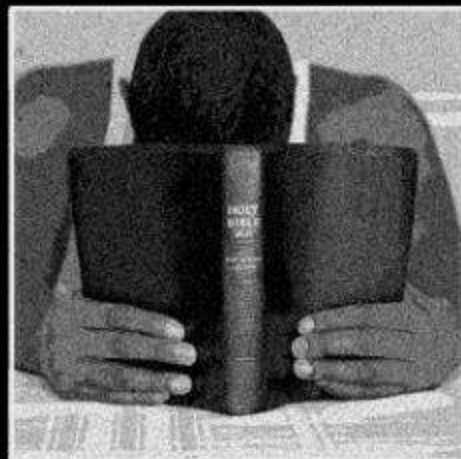
